Slug Killer Legislation

At the end of June shops were prevented from making sales of traditional slug pellets.

Traditional slug pellets contained a product called metaldehyde, which has been banned and will not be permitted for use outside from early 2020. This means that any gardener who has stock of traditional products will be required to use these before June next year.

The really good news is that the manufacturers of these products have been busy working on alternative environmentally friendly products to help protect our valuable plant and vegetable gardens. At Brundall Home Hardware we now carry a variety of products which you can safely use



in your garden. We would very much appreciate customer feedback on these new products so that we can refine our range and provide the very best value and advice to our customers.




